**The Practice:**

College takes the feedback from students, faculty and other stakeholders regarding curriculum and its implementation and also introduces value added courses. The students are continuously evaluated through home assignments, presentations, written tests, quiz and elocution programs etc.

The Industry interaction is sought by inviting faculty from the industry to give talks to motivation, providing skill and orientation and disseminate information related to the field and also help in career choice for the students. Also field visits are conducted to industry sites to
