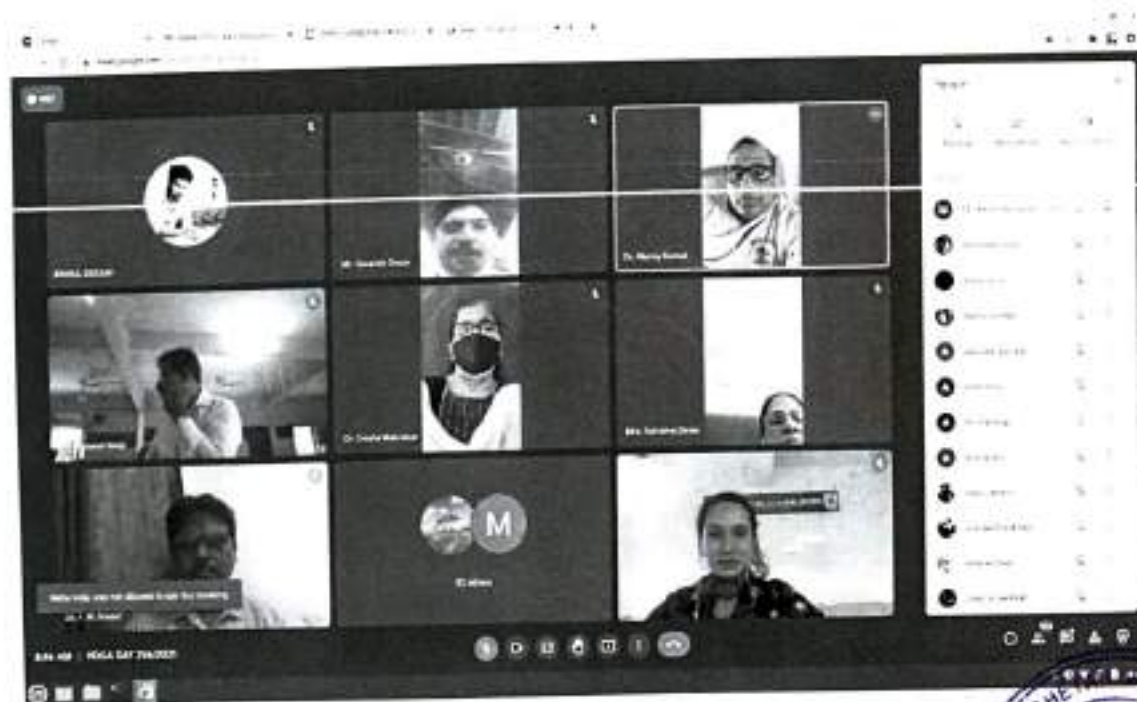

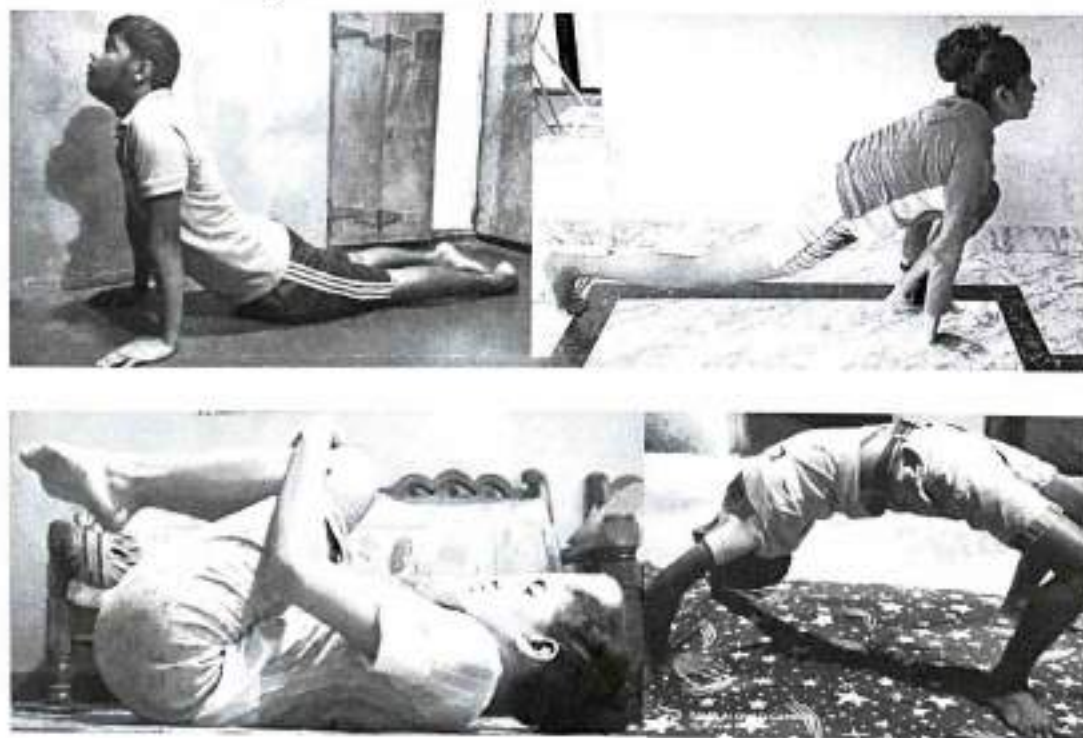

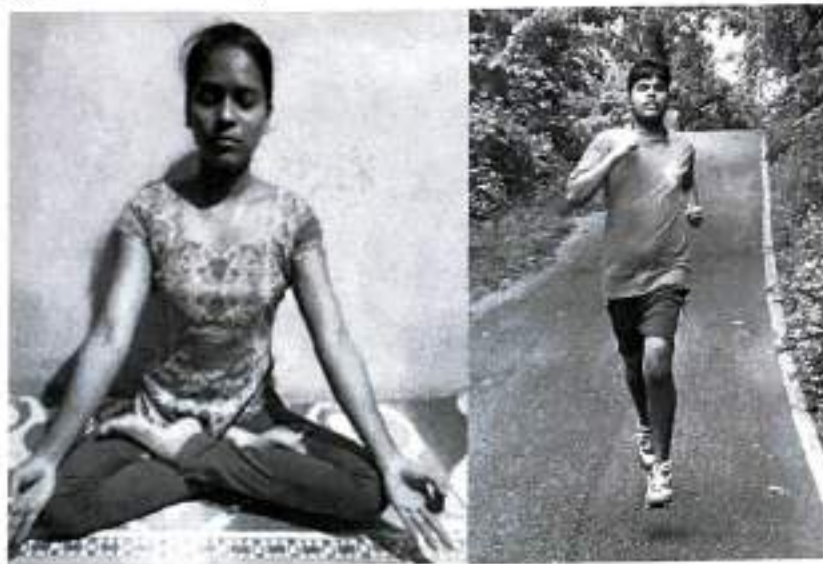

REPORT OF THE FREE MEDICAL CAMP HELD AT KHOLA, CANACONA

Center for Extension Activity of DPM's Shree Mallikarjun College of Arts & Commerce in association with the Board of Extra Mural Studies & Extension Services of Goa University conducted a FREE MEDICAL CAMP at Khola Village Panchayat, Canacona on 19th March 2017.

Khola Village Panchayat of Canacona was selected to hold Free Medical Camp for following reasons:

- Khola is one of the remotest and backward villages in Canacona taluka.
- Khola village is adopted by Hon. Member of Parliament, South Goa Shri. Narendra Sawaikar under Sansad Adarsh Gram Yojana (SAGY) to make this village as Ideal Village in Goa.
- Khola village has population of 5382 of which 2779 are males while 2603 are females as per Population Census 2011.
- About 56 percent of the population of the village consists of tribals and about another 20 percent of the population consists of fishing community.
- The village lacks basic health facilities. For minor health issues, villagers have to travel to Margao or Chaudi.

Dr. Manoj Prabhudesai, Junior Consultant, Orthopedic Surgery, Goa Medical College, Bambolim-Goa inaugurated the camp in the presence of Shri. Shanu Velip Member Zilla Panchayat, Shri. Ajay Pagi Sarpanch Khola Village Panchayat, Shri. Rajiv Naik Gaonkar Secretary Khola Village Panchayat, Dr. F. M. Nadaf Officialting Principal of Shree Mallikarjun College, Canacona, and Dr. Anthony Viegas Director of Board of Extra Mural Studies & Extension Services of Goa University.

No. of Beneficiaries:

225 needy villagers of Khola Village Panchayat took the direct advantage of the Medical Camp. Patients ranged from small children to elderly people. Majority of the patients were females.



Services offered during the Camp:

- Bone Mineral Density Test
- Diabetes Detection
- Uric Acid Test
- Orthopedic Examination
- General Physical Examination

All the patients were subjected to Blood Test, Uric Test and Bone Mineral Density Test.

In the market approximately these three tests may cost Rs. 950/- per patient. During the health camp all the diagnosed patients were given free medicines worth Rs. 300/- per patient.





Outcome of the Camp:


During the Medical Camp, doctors detected following 81 new cases:



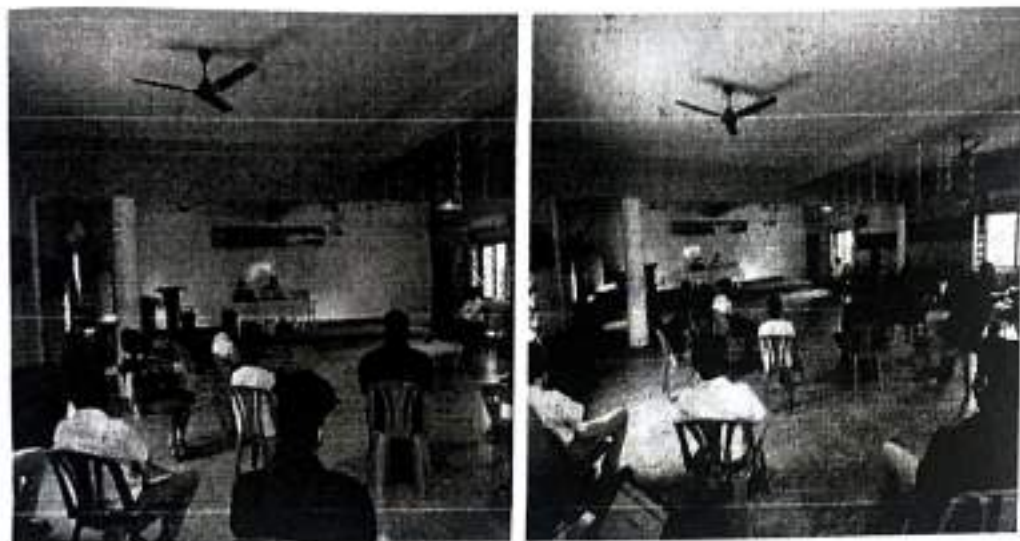
