Lecture on Gender Equity

Department of Sociology organised a talk on 'Gender Equaity' by Advocate Ms. Deepali Agrasani on 05.04.19. Dr. Arvind N. Haldankar, HOD sociology welcomed and introduced the Guest speaker. Ms Agrasani focused on types of inequalities existing in our society at different places in different forms. The three types of gender inequalities are national gender inequality, household inequality, and property inequality. The speaker explained the above forms of inequalities with lucid examples. One of the examples of household gender inequality was her maid being left by her husband only because she was unable to give birth to baby boy. This example portrays the kind of a declining value and blame, our society attaches to women. Presently, the Indian society demonstrates a mixed bag of attitudes towards women. While some cultures are very liberal there are others where the discriminatory practices are on a rise, she added. The people of Goa are fortunate enough to avail of egalitarian laws such as the Uniform Civil Code. The law is upheld hitherto even when Portuguese regime has come to an end a long time ago.

Secondly, the speaker explained the importance of Domestic Violence Act 2005 ensuring protection for women in the household domain. She also spoke on the trajectory of law and the procedural hindrances confronted by women especially the illiterate ones. Ms Agrasani stressed the need to have efficient legal systems in place to facilitative justice in a speedy manner. A total of 35 students attended the programme. A Visit to Sateri Self Help Group



Visit to Shree Santeri Self Help Group Gaval Khola

As a part of the curriculum a field visit was undertaken to Shree Santeri Self Help Group Gaval Khola self-help group of Gaval Khola, Cabo De Rama on 12.10.2018. Assistant Professor Mrs. Vithai Zaraunker accompanied the students. Shree Sateri SHG is one of the oldest groups in the village Khola registered under the SHGs around eight years ago. This group consists of 17 members formed to help each other through their little collection and hard work inputs.

Functioning

It is learnt that the group conducts meetings once in a week and collects a sum of rupees fifty from every member a month. One of the members takes the response further the position of the money in the bank. Apart from this, the members participate collectively in agricultural

tubers. These women are also active in the cultural domain. Their *fugdi*, *kalsi* and *divli* dances in the taluka and state competitions have brought them laurels in the cultural festivals like *Shigmo*.

The pooled money is used for purposes such as education of children, marriages, festivals such as Ganesh chaturthi, birthdays or in times when there is a dire need. They only give the loans to their group member's on interest @ Rs.1 on Rs. 100. Some landless village men borrow land on rent. The rent on land cost is generally around rupces. 400, and is at times also determined as per the use of land, Thus, one may ascertain the fact that the Self Help Groups help the women in mobilising the resources and cultivating a spirit of collective participation.



Medical camp for women to be organised on 07.09.2018 in Gaondongrem. Medical experts from the field of genaecology, general medicine, nutrition, etc. will be appointed for the task. The advisory members suggested to seek the involvement of local Member of Legislative Assembly Shri Isidore Fernandes. It was decided to depute five volunteers from the college to assist the activity. Awareness modes such as college, press report, press inserts, street plays, and banners were also discussed. Menstrual Health Camp: It was proposed to organised a menstrual health camp exclusively for the students of Shree Mallikarjun College, Canacona.

The Department of Sociology Shree Mallikarjun College of Arts Commerce and Science in association with "Sangath" organized a workshop on "Gender Awareness" by Prachi Prabhu Research Scholar at the Advanced Centre of Women's Studies, Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Mumbai on 18th January 2019. Five faculty members and 112 students attended the workshop.

Objectives of the workshop:

1. The training aimed to increase gender awareness among participants

2. To help challenge discriminatory practices and inculcate inclusive environment

Activity/Process: This workshop aimed at making students aware of gender as social construction. It aimed to raise awareness among participants about issues robited to gender.

Themes covered:

 Gender and Sex: Understanding the difference between gender and sex. To unlearn the different social constructs of gender.

2. Gender based discrimination and Violence: this discussion included challenging various forms of discrimination such as stereotypes, emotional and physical abuse and understanding the manifestations of these in everyday lives

3. Gender equality: This discussion was centered on the ideas of equality and need for it. It also discussed the various ways of how inclusion and equality can be practiced in our lives. This session raised awareness among students about gender discrimination and the need for challenging the same.

Firstly, Dr Arvind Haldankar Head Department of Sociology introduced the theme of the workshop. Principal Dr. Manoj Kamat welcomed and introduced the speaker Smt. Prachi Prabhu and emphasized the need to debate and discuss issues concerning gender in the Indian society. Soon after the welcome, the speaker dealt with issues such as Gender trouble and gender inequality arising out of it. She explained as to how society looks at men and women differently and in turn also attribute roles in distinct manner. Furthermore, the students learnt about the basic distinction between sex and gender. While sex refers to biologically properties, gender is to be understood as a socially constructed variable. The distinction between the two was deliberated with a multiple illustrations. Ms Prabhu posed some fundamental questions before the students of how people negotiate with our lives in shaping our experiences in determining the idea of gender. She spoke about the process of socialization handled by agencies such as family, school, community, office, media, religion and division of labour.

Secondly, the speaker discussed male domination and the concomitant gender discriminatory practices resulting in violence against women. It is evident from this fact that women face more problems than men in the Indian society. The LGBT (lesbian, gay,



bisexual, transgender) community is yet another social component which is more vulnerable to problems. Violence against women in any form is an offence and gender discrimination is not to be viewed as women issue but a human issue, remarked Ms Prachi. Ms. Drusila Fernandes from Third Year Bachelor of Arts class thanked the speaker on behalf of College and the Sociology Department.
