

COLLEGE ADMISSION POLICY:

The institute has an Open Door Policy for Equitable Access to all (ODPEA), primarily, First Generation Learners and on the principle of EFA -'Education For All' especially Socially and Economically Disadvantaged Learners. This excludes the need to have a Merit-Based Entrance Test to segregate learners. However, the college conducts a Subject Proficiency Test to ascertain the competency of learners.

PROCESS:

- a) Reservation Policy of Government followed in spirit and letters
- b) Fast Track Admission for Meritorious Students
- c) Subject Specific Career Counseling along with Parent
- d) One-on-one Interview with Admission Committee & Principal
- e) Help for Needy Students to avail financial assistance
- f) Subject Proficiency Test



Admissions

RESERVATION POLICY:

For admission to all the classes, Reservation Policy of Government of Goa and University Grants Commission will be followed:

Reservation for Schedule Caste (SC):

2 % of the seats available are reserved for the applicants belonging to any of the following five castes on the production of caste certificate from Competent Authority. Castes include: Bhangui, Mahar, Mang, Chambhar (Hadi) & Ahyavanshi (Vankar)

Reservation for Schedule Tribe (ST):

12 % of the seats available are reserved for the applicants belonging to any of the following eight castes on the production of caste certificate from Competent Authority. Castes include: Dhodia (Halpati), Naikda (Nayaka), Varli, Gawda, Dubla (Talavia), Siddi, Kunbi & Velip.

Reservation for Other Backward Community (OBC):

27 % of the seats available are reserved for the applicants belonging to any of the following caste on the production of caste certificate from Competent Authority. Castes include: Bhandari Naik Koli, Satarkar, Christian Barber, Kharvi (I/c Christian Kharvi), Shimpi, Christian Mahar Kalaikar/Black Smith, Thakar, Vishwakarma /Chari/ Mesta, Kumbhar (I/c Christian Kumbhar) Teli, Dhangar, Mahalo, Nabhik, Nai, Napit, Nhavi, Christian Renders, Dhobi, Rajak, Madval (I/ Christian Dhobi), Nathjogi, Komarpant, Gosavi & Pagui/Gabit.

Reservation for Physically Handicapped (PH):

In accordance with the provisions of Section 39 of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act 1995 (Central Act 1 of 1996), a person suffering from not less than 40% (forty percent) disability shall be eligible for the consideration under this Category. 3 % of the seats are reserved for this category. Applicants claiming reservation under this category shall be eligible on the production of Certificate from the Medical Board of Goa Medical College.

Reservation for Freedom Fighters (FF):

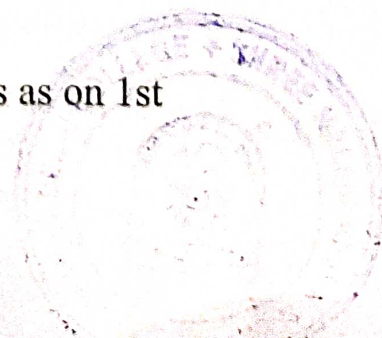
1% of the seats are reserved for the children of Registered Freedom Fighters from Goa shall be eligible under this category provided they produce relevant documents from the competent authorities.

Note: Admission is based on first come first served basis. If students are not available from the reserved category, those seats will be filled from general category. Similarly, if students are not available from the general category seats will be filled from reserved category.

PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION

Application Form along with Prospectus for Admission must be obtained from the College Office during working hours on working days on a payment of Rs. 200/. A student seeking admission should duly fill in prescribed form and meet the Admission Committee accompanied by the Parents/Guardians. No Admission for any class will be granted without being accompanied by the Parents/ Guardians for counseling. All admissions are valid for one academic year only. Students desirous of seeking admission to the College for First Year B.A./B.Com will have to submit their application in the prescribed form along with:

1. Four Identity Card size Photographs
2. Leaving Certificate (Original + 1 photocopy)
3. Mark Sheet of HSSC/XII (Original + 2 photocopies)
4. Eligibility Certificate for students from other than Goa University & Goa Board
5. SC/ST/OBC Certificates (If applicable)
6. Fees in full as per the schedule of fees for the year 2019-20.
7. Anti-Ragging Affidavit by the Student & Guardian on stamp paper or copy of the online registration (www.antiragging.in, www.amanmovement.org)
(Compulsory for First Year, Second Year & Third Year Students).
8. Undertaking for Attendance
9. Aadhar Card Photocopy
10. Bank Passbook only for SC/ST/OBC Students
11. Voter I. D. Card (If you do not have and completing 18 years as on 1st January 2020 please fill Form No. 6)

ADDENDUM

The following paras shall be added after para (6) of the Circular read in preamble:-

Reservation in admission for persons with benchmark disabilities.

It is also stated here that in terms of Section 34 of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, 4% reservation is available for persons with benchmark disabilities as shown below:-

One percent each shall be reserved for persons with benchmark disabilities under clauses (a), (b) and (c) and one percent, under clauses (d) and (e)

- (a) Blindness and low vision
- (b) Deaf and hard of hearing
- (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid attack victim and muscular dystrophy.
- (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness
- (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under clauses (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness.

In case any seat remains vacant due to non-availability of student in any above categories, the same may be interchanged among the above mentioned categories.

All Government/Aided Colleges/Goa University shall follow the above mentioned reservation in admission of persons with benchmark disabilities in all India seats and local domicile seats.

CIRCULAR

National Commission for Backward Classes has received complaints against the National Law Universities / Schools stating that there are irregularities in the process of admission thereby violating the reservation rules.

National Commission for Backward Classes New Delhi has therefore issued guidelines on 20.1.2020 (A copy enclosed) regarding implementation of reservation in admission. Commission has observed that National Law Universities and State Government Universities which are established under Statutes enacted by the State Legislature and also received grant-in-aid from UGC and State Government are not following rule of reservation in admission. The Statute provide reservation for local domicile candidate and for the all India seats in their admission. And few of the Universities are providing reservation only in the local domicile percentage of seats and not in the all India seats.

The Commission has therefore recommended that the reservation rules in admission of OBC candidates (27%) in all India seats and local domicile seats may strictly be followed for the admission of academic year starting from 2020 onwards.

All the Government Colleges, Aided Colleges and Goa University shall strictly implement the reservation rule in admission for OBC Categories (27%).

Therefore, Colleges shall maintain the reservation as follows:

1) Other Backward Classes (OBC)	27%
2) Schedule Caste (SC)	2%
3) Schedule Tribes (ST)	12%
4) Economically Weaker Section (EWS)	10%

All the Government Colleges, Aided Colleges and Goa University shall strictly implement the reservation rule in admission for all above categories in all India seats and local domicile seats.

If any seats reserved for all above categories remain vacant, the same shall be filled by general student.
