2. The students were also informed about how careful they have to be while selecting an investment option.

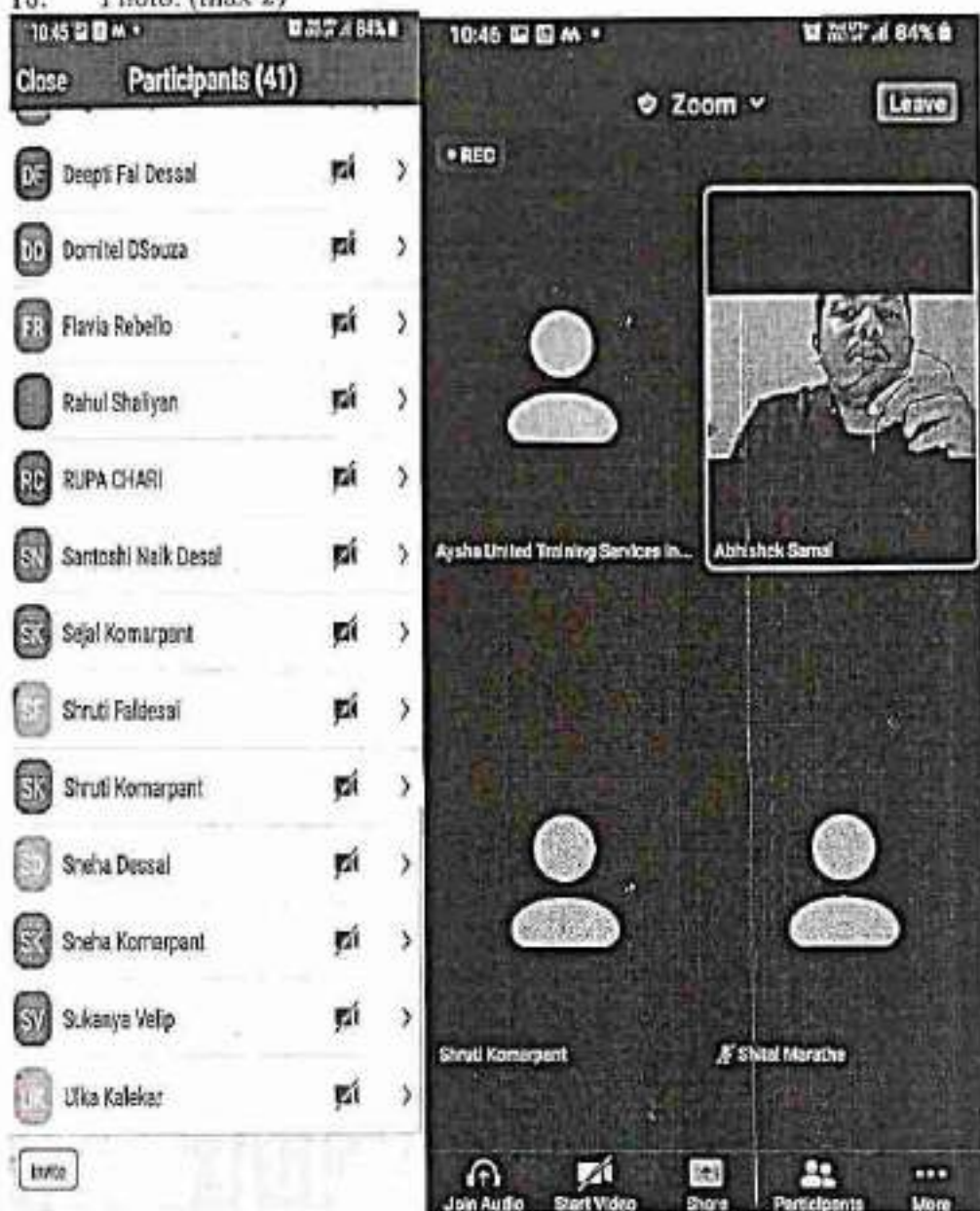

The Principal Dr. Manoj Kamat also contributed his thoughts on the topic under deliberation which added an opening score to the event.

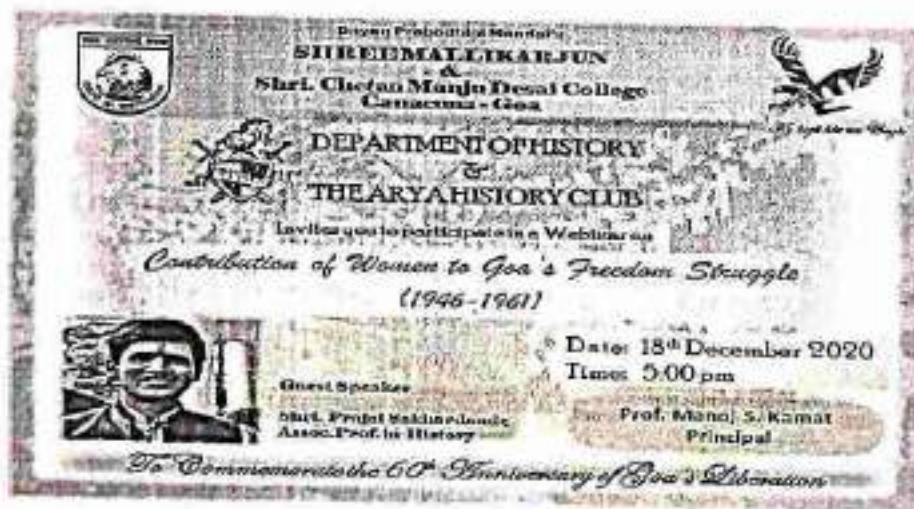
Mr. Prajal Sakhardande spoke at length on the women's contribution, their sacrifices and significant role of women in the freedom struggle.

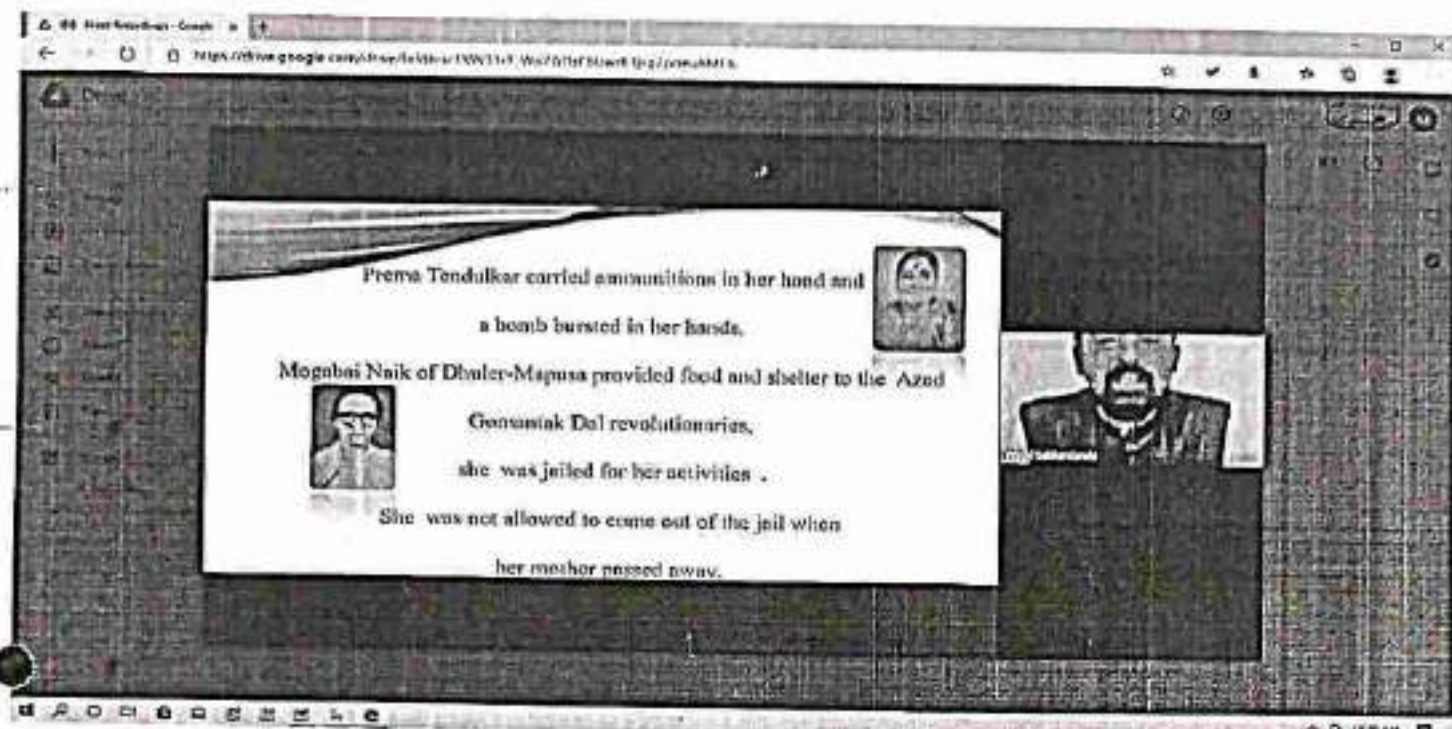
The deliberation was followed by discussion and opened to questions.

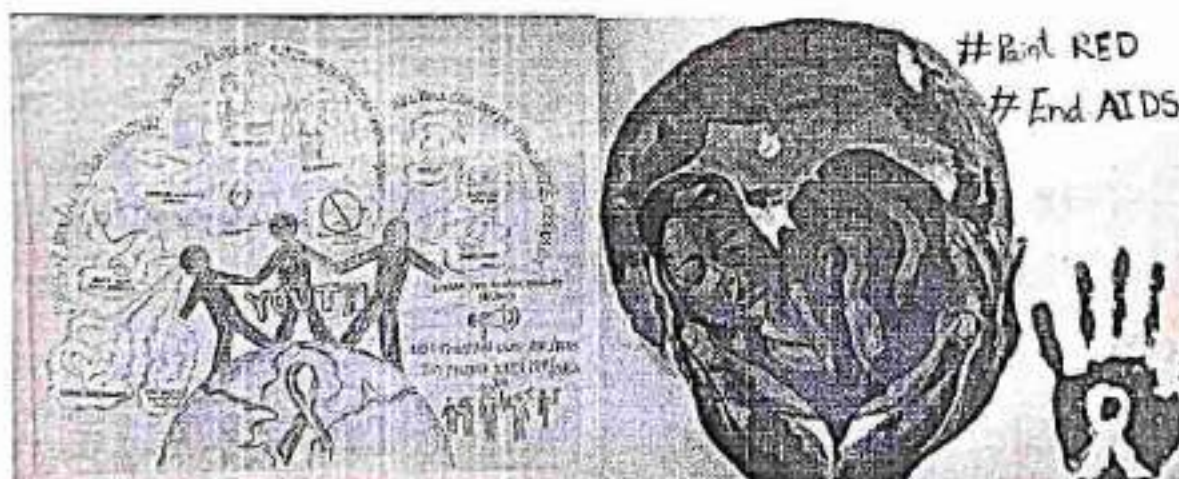
Celebration of International and National Days

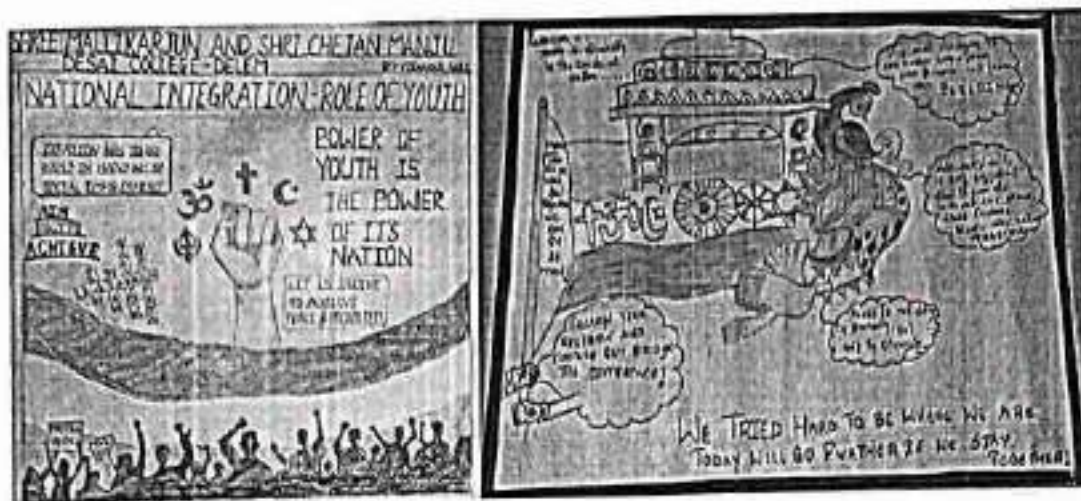
2. NSS Day

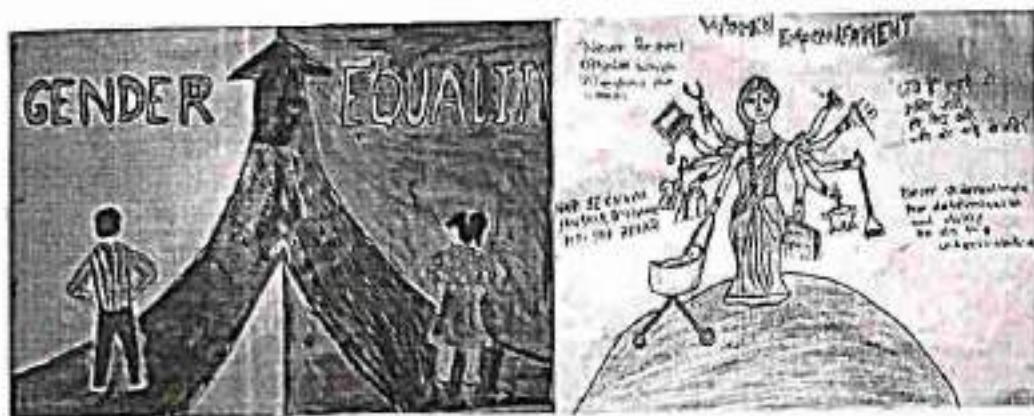

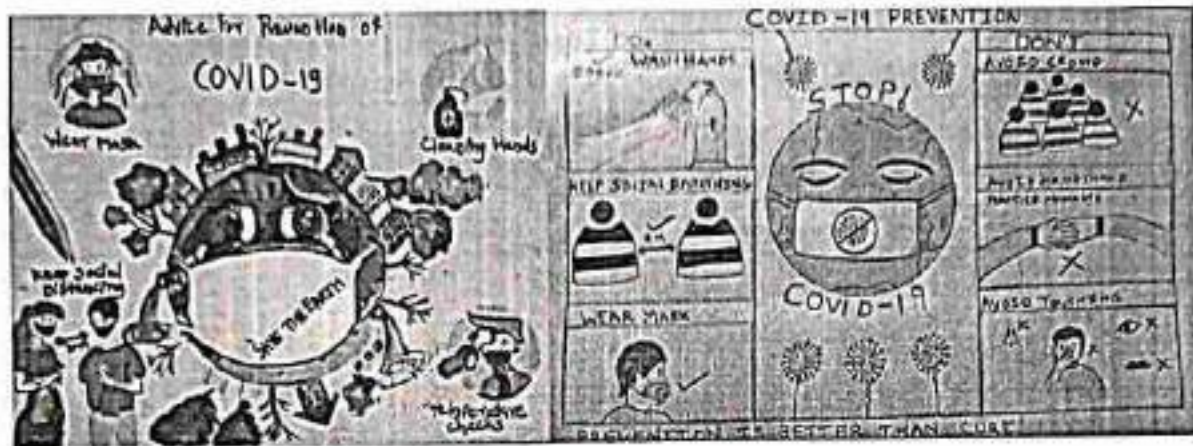


In order to make awareness on corona virus and COVID-19 pandemic for effective control on its spread, posters were made on **Appropriate**

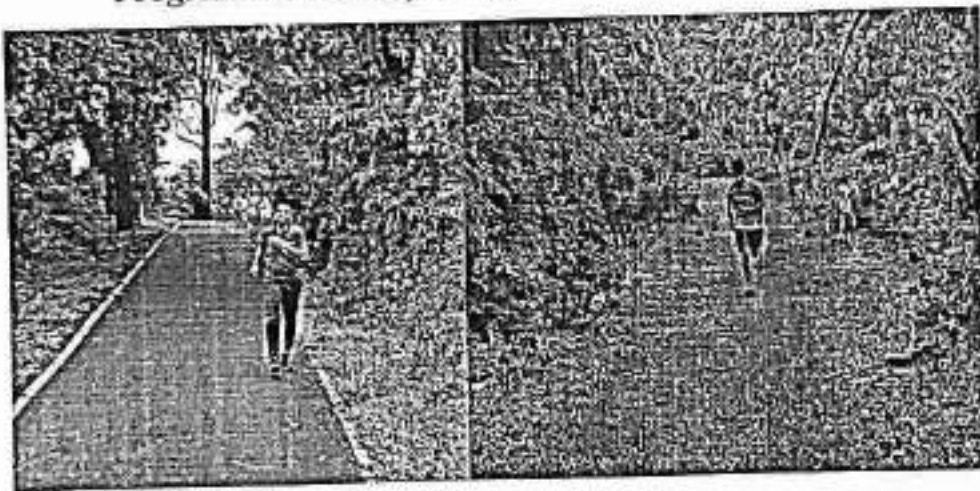


Swachh Bharat Programmes

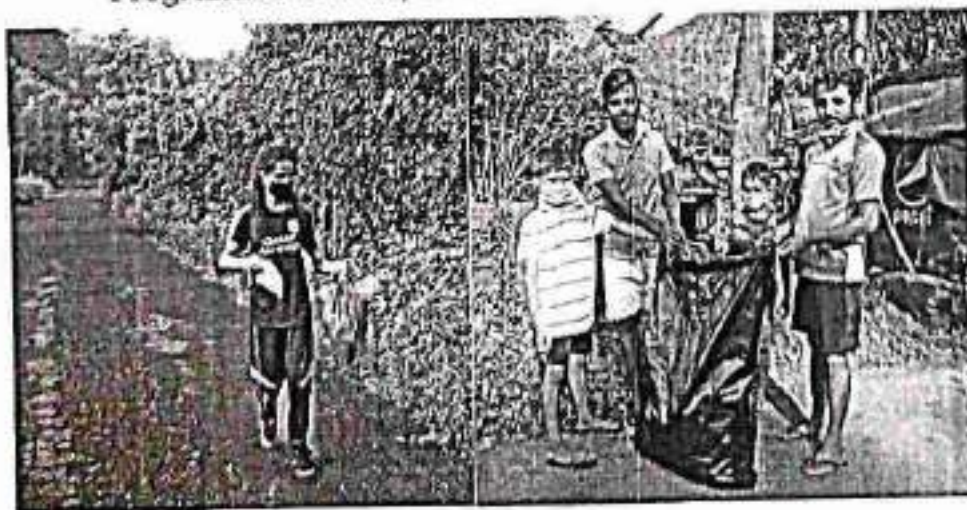
