DEPARTMENT OF GEOGRAPHY ACTIVITIES REPORT YEAR 2016-17


In continuation with the aim to strive for community development through empowerment of individual, the Department of Geography carried out number of activities in the academic year of 2016-17.

BEST PRACTICES

Conduct of field visits

Organization of field visits is one of the best practices of the Geography Department. In order to give practical exposure to the geographical features, the Department conducts field visits at regular interval. The object of such visits is to understand spatial variation of geographical attributes and its relation with multi-dimensional forces.

 On 28th August 2016, 41 students along with 3 staff members visited places like Sawari, Bhupar and Tarir to get familiar with distinct landforms such as waterfall, rapids, beaches etc.



 An exposure visit to polyhouses in association with Department of Agriculture, Canacona Division was conducted on 6th October 2016 with 28 students and 2 staff members. The team learned about new farming techniques adopted by progressive farmers. The farms located in Netravali, Khotigao and Poinginim were visited.






Between 24/12/2016 and 31/12/2016, a team of 14 students of TYBA Geography class and 2 assisting teaching staff visited southern part of Western Ghats and coastal lands in the state of Kerala and Tamil Nadu. The objective of this study tour was to observe and contrast distinct landform of southern peninsular India with its backwater system to the uniqueness of Goan geographical identity, The change in the type of forest, its variation with height, ravines, gorges, convex hill tops, wide and connected backwater network, climatic changes with the proximity to the equator were the focus of the study. Besides these, change in food habits, attire, language and other

cultural attributes were also studied. The team visited the places like Munnar, Kottayam, Tiruvanantapuram, Kannyakumari, Kochi and Mangalore during this 8 days study tour.





 To keep updated about surrounding environmental conditions, 01 day field visit was conducted in Vasco town and the vicinity area on 2rd March 2017. The stress of the study was on knowing the functioning of Goa Shipyard Limited as well as the state of environment around Mormugao Port Trust. In all 112 students of FYBA class and 3 teaching faculty visited the sites.



 Students opted for Tourism subject at SYBA visited Humpi and adjoining area in the state of Karnataka between 3rd March 2017 and 5th March 2017.
 The team studied the advantages and potentialities of the place with respect to tourism. In all 17 students and 01 teacher participated in the event.







Record and display of weather observation

Another best practice of the Department is recording and display of weather observations. With the help of Automatic Weather Station located in the college campus, the students of FYBA class record and display weather data on daily basis.

ENVIRONMENT ENRICHMENT PROGRAMME

- To increase understanding about environment, a lecture series is being conducted. On 17th July 2016, a lecture on 'Agricultural practices in Canacona taluka' was delivered by shri. Shivram Desai, Zonal Agricultural Officer, Canacona Division.
- A guest lecture on the topic of 'Soil characteristics and agricultural crops'
 was organized on 22rd August 2016. The resource person shri. K. B. Gaonkar,
 Secretary, DPM Canacona discussed various issues pertaining to soil
 development in the surrounding area.
- To help carbon sequestration process and ecological balance, tree plantation programme is being conducted annually. On July 01, 2016 trees were planted in the college campus and along the road side.
- On 3rd September 2016, an inter-class matoli and biodiversity display competition was organized by Geotarang (Geography Club) in association with Friends of Nature.




got to know about the modern exploration methods operating in the field of ocean basins research and weather observation area.






The city of Bengaluru and vicinity area was visited between 14th and 17th of February 2018 by the students of Tourism Geography.
