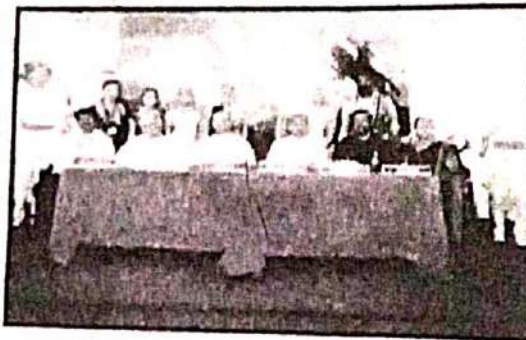

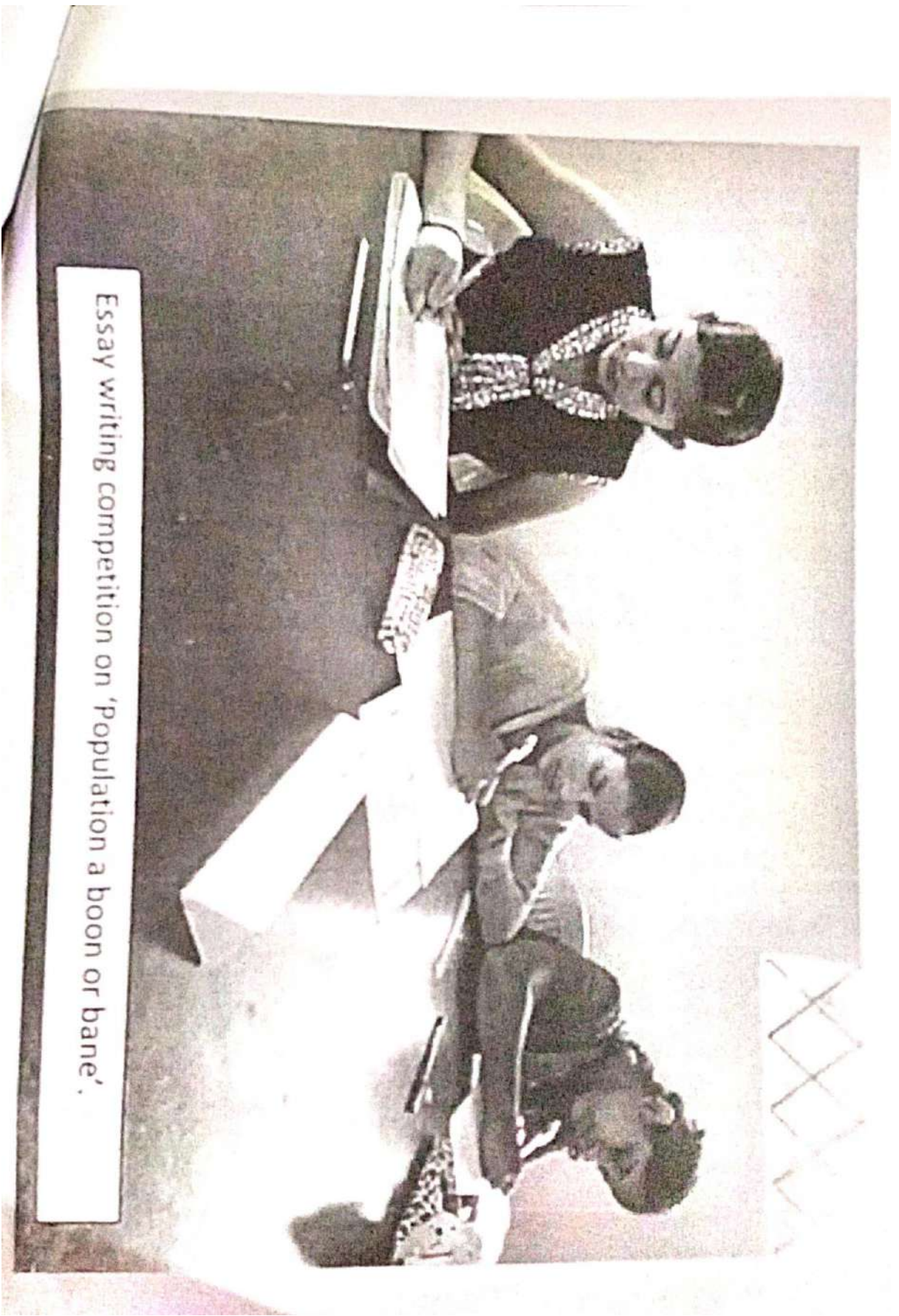

The objectives were: In keeping with the government's initiative of 'Beti Bachao' this was a small initiative on the part of dept. of History in collaboration with the ARYA History Club.

The objective being:

- Prevention of gender biased sex selective elimination
- Ensuring survival & protection of the girl child
- Ensuring education and participation of the girl child

A talk to the student was also arranged on the topic addressed by Ms. Domitel D'Souza and the event was co-ordinated by Ms. Tanvi Naik.

The trend of the decline in the Child Sex Ratio (CSR) was highlighted and the CSR as major indicator of women disenpowerment. The pre-birth discrimination reflected through gender biased sex selection, and post birth discrimination against girls as seen in the social fields leading to lower Child Sex Ratio and the need for awareness and a change in mindset required was the center of the talk delivered.

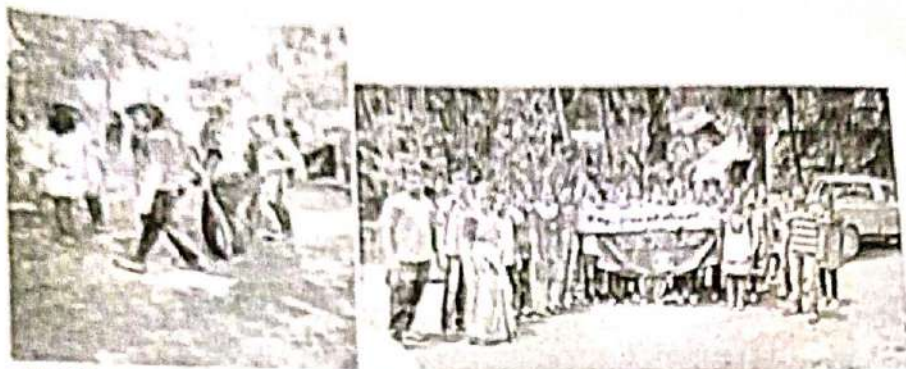




