





**IQAS:**

Various **QUALITY INITIATIVES** for improving teaching learning process have been taken up by the IQAS.

**THE INNOVATIVE METHODOLOGIES INCLUDES:**

1.	Course Outline & AAA (Academic and Administrative Audit). The course of syllabus completion is charted through the Course Outline Exercise- Were the teacher keeps the record of every lecture & activity engaged in by the faculty members.
2.	Attendance regulated.
3.	Department/ Activity Reports Mandatory with financial statement wherever necessary.
4.	Course Enhancement Initiatives/ laying the syllabus objectives and learning Outcomes. The syllabus has to be with its objectives & learning outcomes. The teachers aim at fulfilling the outcomes & objectives in the teaching process. The curriculum evaluation takes place at the level of the teacher & at the level of the student. The syllabus is provided by the University. In case the objectives & outcomes are not outlined the teachers concerned try to bridge the gap by laying out its own objectives & outcomes.
5.	The institution reviews its teaching-learning process through the student's feedback at regular intervals. Accordingly the teachers get a clue as to the changes to be made in the teaching-learning process.
6.	The IQAC conducts orientations (Teaching and Evaluation) for the fresh faculty members on a one-to-one basis and Group.
7.	The IQAC also conducts FDPs on different methodologies in teaching like the LOTS to HOTS teaching model of Revised Bloom's Taxonomy & other methodologies like cooperative learning, experiential learning & learning by doing.

Synchronous which is real time teaching was conducted to impart learning and established through training and use of ICT technology such as Google Suit; Google Meet to have real time interaction with the students.

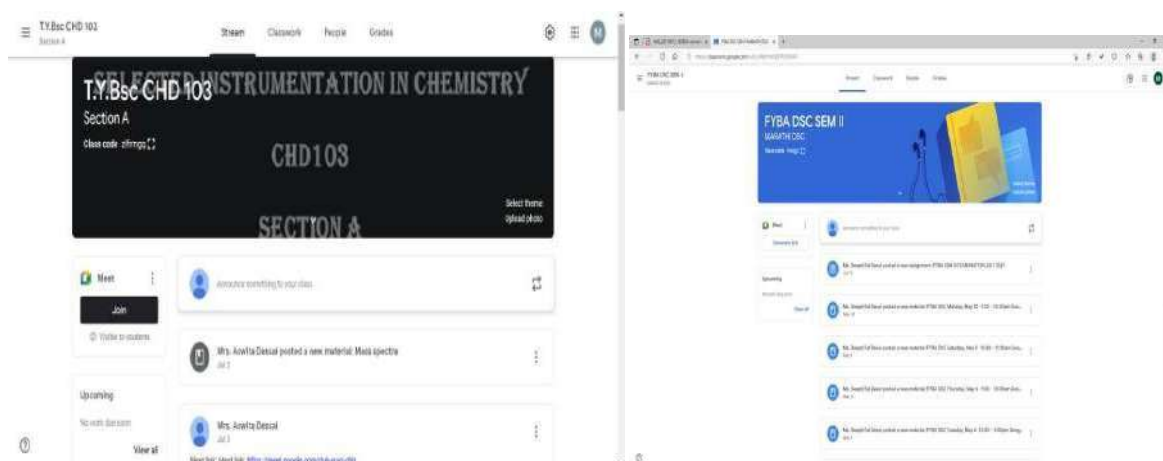
The time table committee prepared the lecture schedule. **SEMESTER PLAN, WEEKLY RECORD** had to be submitted to the administration.

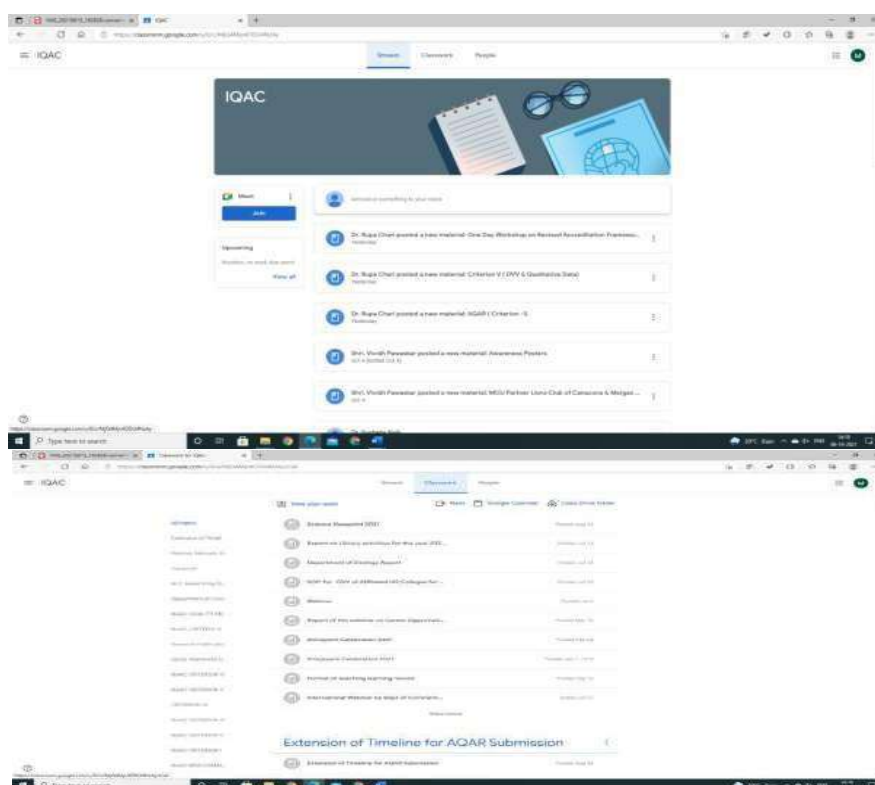

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
