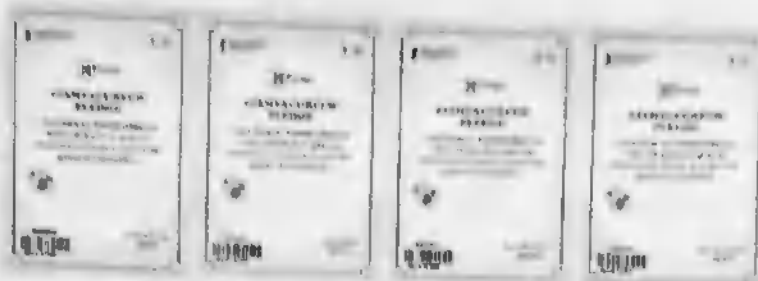
Social Awareness during COVID-19 Pandemic

- Students in their final year of graduation, post-graduation students and college alumni will be eligible to join the programme. Students in the first and second year of graduation are not eligible.
- Bajaj Finserv will select, train and deploy the trainers to deliver the programme. The remuneration, travelling and conveyance expenses of the trainers, will be paid by Bajaj Finserv. The college partner will provide necessary training infrastructure like a smart class, computer lab etc.

- 1) **FINSEV** has appointed different training institutes as Official Training Partners for conducting CPBFI (hereinafter referred to as CPBFI Official Training Partners).
- 2) **FINSEV** and the **PARTNER INSTITUTE**, through one of the CPBFI Official Training Partners, shall conduct, for the eligible students and alumni of the **PARTNER INSTITUTE** a Certificate Programme in Banking, Finance and Insurance viz. CPBFI, covering industry overview and product knowledge about Banking, Financial Services and Insurance (BFSI) industry and communication skills.

3. Responsibilities of the Parties:

- 1) The **PARTNER INSTITUTE** shall be responsible for marketing students for the CPBFI Programme by spreading awareness about CPBFI and its potential benefits for the prospective students. **FINSEV** shall, as requested by **PARTNER INSTITUTE**, at its discretion, support the awareness campaigns by participating in the student meetings, parent meetings and design of publicity material such as posters, leaflets etc.

PARTNER INSTITUTE shall ensure proper security required for training purposes such as master keys, cash guards, etc.
- vi) The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall ensure a **hardware** for every CPBT batch, with following **commitment**
- a. To motivate and encourage students to extract maximum benefit from CPBT
 - b. To provide necessary support to the CPBT Official Training Partner for planning and conducting the program
 - c. To conduct online pre assessment and post assessment tests for every batch
 - d. To ensure that the classes are conducted as per pre defined schedule
 - e. To ensure that all students are regularly attending the classes
 - f. To maintain daily attendance of students
 - g. To attend late classes as an observer and provide feedback to FMSSE about the learning quality
 - h. To ensure discipline and good conduct from the students
 - i. To support FMSSE team to conduct CPBT or Workshop for every batch
 - j. To submit regular college information as per Annexure 1 to FMSSE's coordinator
- vii) The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall issue an appointment letter to the Coordinator as per format provided in Annexure 4 of this MOU. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall submit the appointment letter duly signed by the Principal of the PARTNER INSTITUTE and accepted by the Coordinator to FMSSE before commencement of every CPBT Batch.
- viii) FMSSE shall be responsible to design and continuously improve the CPBT programme structure, including adding or deleting courses, changing pedagogy or modifications to the programme duration.
- ix) FMSSE shall be responsible to arrange faculty with requisite expertise and experience. Through any of its CPBT Official Training Partners, FMSSE shall provide necessary details of the concerned CPBT Official Training Partner to the PARTNER INSTITUTE at least 2 weeks before start of every batch.
- x) FMSSE and the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall be responsible for award of "Certificate of Completion" at the completion of CPBT to all successful candidates who meet eligibility criteria viz. requisite attendance and studies in the examinations conducted during CPBT.
- xi) FMSSE, as part of its CME, shall bear the full cost of faculty deployed by its CPBT Official Training Partner.
- xii) To ensure that CPBT is accessible to students belonging to economically weaker sections of the society.
- xiii) FMSSE along with its chosen academic partner/s, shall conduct an online examination at the end of CPBT. Only students who pass this examination shall be eligible to receive the "Certificate of Completion". This examination shall be in addition to all other examinations conducted by the CPBT Official Training Partner during CPBT.

4. Batch Strength:

The parties agree that, each batch shall consist of students 30 and maximum 45 students. FURTHER and the BIDDING CONTRACTOR may mutually decide to start a batch with less than 30 students.

5. Terms of the MOU:

the term of this MOU is for Three years commencing from 2020 to 2023 except Clause 5(a) and Clause 7, which shall continue to be in force for a further period of 3 years from the date of termination of this MOU. The parties may decide to further extend the term of this MOU by mutual consent on each term and condition it may be varied between them.

4. Course fees:

PARTNER INSTITUTE shall charge a non-refundable fee of Rs. _____ (Rupees _____) towards the course fee inclusive of GST and other taxes. The fee payable by each student shall not be less than Rs. 1,000 (Rupees One thousand only) plus applicable taxes. The fees payable fee shall be used for two parts: firstly to meet all the needs of CPBF and secondly to reward the staff members for their effort towards successful conduct of CPBF batch. The fee subsidy shall be paid by FINSERV within 2 weeks from completion of every batch and submission of bank account information as per Annexure 1. The method for calculating the overall attendance is included in Annexure 2.

- (i) For successful completion of every batch i.e. if the overall attendance of the students is in excess of 75%, FINSERV shall pay an amount of Rs. 100 (Rupees One hundred only) per student to the PARTNER INSTITUTE as a fee subsidy. The PARTNER INSTITUTE may utilize this amount to compensate the teachers and other staff members for their effort towards successful conduct of CPBF batch. The fee subsidy shall be paid by FINSERV within 2 weeks from completion of every batch and submission of bank account information as per Annexure 1. The method for calculating the overall attendance is included in Annexure 2.
- (ii) The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall ensure that no student shall be allowed to attend CPBF without paying the fee.
- (iii) The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall submit to FINSERV before commencement of every batch, extracts of bank statement or copies of cash receipts or a letter from the Principal or Vice-Principal confirming collection of fee from every participant.

7. Duration and contents of CPBF:

- (a) CPBF shall commence from APRIL, 2020. The said Programme will be of about 3 week duration and will involve class room teaching of about 120 hours.
- (b) The PARTNER INSTITUTE has agreed to mobilise, on best effort basis, at least 40 students in first academic year and at least 80 students from second academic year onwards. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall decide the batch schedule and timings and inform the schedule to FINSERV at least 45 days before commencement of the batch.
- (c) FINSERV shall arrange to make the faculty available as per the schedule informed by the PARTNER INSTITUTE.
- (d) Detailed schedule of the lectures and practical shall be given in advance to students before commencement of CPBF.

8. Place of teaching:

- (a) The class room teaching and practical shall be conducted at DPM'S SHREE MALIKARJUN & SHRI CHETAN MANOH DESAI COLLEGE, CANACONA by the CPBF Official Training Partner for up to four hours a day on such days, dates and at such timings as may be mutually decided between the parties.

9. Eligibility for CPBF:

- (i) Any student who is studying in the final year of Undergraduate Programme or pursuing any post-graduate programme shall be eligible to apply for admission to CPBF.

The parties having discussed the field of common interests for training, research and allied activities between the two institutions, have decided to enter into a collaboration.

Whereas, GIPARD, earlier known as Goa Institute of Rural Development & Administration (GIRDA), is established under notification No. 10/1/2014 PIR (Part) in the Official Gazette, Series I No. 15 dated 10/07/2014 is the State of Goa's apex autonomous training institute, catering to training, capacity building, research and consultancy activities. The major target audience being elected representatives, officials, functionaries of government departments, Non Government Organisations, Self Help Groups, academicians and students.

Whereas, Dayan Prabhodhini Mandal's Shree Mallikarjun College is a premier institution in the State of Goa that provides higher education and is actively involved in research, training and consultancy. It has been accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) with a cumulative grade point average of 2.81 out of 4.00.

Whereas, there is a need for both parties to work jointly in order to efficiently achieve their goals through mutual sharing and cooperation and collaborate for mutual benefit.

Now, therefore the parties agree to as follows.



- b. The Institution will have to identify one faculty as the coordinator for conducting the programme and research activities.
- c. Budget for each programme will be prepared by OIPAA/II and allotted to the Institute. 70% of the total programme cost towards institutional charges will be provided to the concerned institute, which will include payment of honorarium to Faculty Coordinator/Technical Assistant etc. If any. Funds will be released on a quarterly basis to the Institute.
- d. The concerned institute will adhere to the necessary arrangements required for conducting the programme as per details mentioned in Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) enclosed with the MoU.
- e. The Institute will submit bills, vouchers and refund the unutilised funds to OIPAA/II within 15 days after the programme is over.
- f. The evaluation report and the report of the programme group photo should be submitted along with the bills.
- 1.3 Neither party shall be agent, representative, or joint partner of the other party. Neither party shall enter into any contract or commitment on behalf of the other party.
- 1.4 Neither party shall use the name, logo of the other party or any abbreviation thereof without the prior written approval of the other party.
- 1.5 Nothing in this MoU grants either party the permission to create a hyperlink to the other's website, without the written authorization of the other party.

Article - IV

Term, Termination and Amendment

- 4.1 The proposed MoU is non-exclusive and shall be for two years from the date of commencing on 10th September 2019 and ending on 9th September 2021, unless terminated earlier.

- 3.2 CIPARD will prepare a training calendar every year and will allocate the number of training programmes which will be conducted off campus at different levels.









Mentoring Policy

MEANING OF MENTORING

Mentoring is a strategy to provide students with emotional and instrumental support they need to achieve learning goals.

OBJECTIVES OF MENTORING POLICY

The objective behind the programme is:

1. To provide a 'campus based role model' and a role model's message 'I will help you, be whoever you want to be.' The understanding is that the Young people need a helping hand to evolve themselves as responsible citizens and chart a success path in the career they choose.
2. The purpose is also to identify intervening mechanisms to improve the performance of weak students. In this context few ideas have been outlined:
 - a. To focus and motivate students to achieve learning goals and thereby improve their Academic performance.
 - b. To generate interest in academics and other institutional activities amongst students.
 - c. To provide students with information on preparatory courses such as bridge courses, skill courses, etc.

THE PROCESS- MENTORING POLICY

i) **Identification of weak students:** One of the Objective of Mentoring is to identify the specific Learning needs of the students. The student shall be grouped into Slow Learners and Advance Learners.



ii) Identification of mechanism to aid weak students:

Slow Learners and Advance Learners shall be identified based on the student's past Performance/Attendance/Performance in ISA.

iii) Realization of desired outcome: The Strategies to realize the desired outcome-

- a. Conduct Extra-Classes/ Revision Classes/ Practise Sessions/ Home Work
- b. Conduct Personal Counselling
- c. Assist by providing Study Material/ Reference List /PDF Material/YouTube Videos.

iv) The Mentor shall conduct Six Meets in each Term with following Agenda:

- a. Introduction/Orientation to Mentoring Programme.
- b. Orientation about Exam and E- Learning.
- c. Feedback/ Discussion on Limitations in Learning.
- d. General Counselling.
- e. ISA Results and Exam Preparation.
- f. Review of Academic Preparation.

PROCEDURE OF MENTORING POLICY

- a. All The Teaching Faculty serves as 'On Campus Faculty Mentors'.
- b. The Co-ordinator for the Mentoring programme identifies the students to be placed under each mentor.
- c. Personal One to One based meetings to be conducted as the need perceived or need felt by the student.
- d. The students to be provided with campus partners in learning.
- e. For interaction the students shall be integrated through the Whatsapp Group.

Desired result of improvement of academic performance of weak students shall be achieved by implementation of the mentoring policy procedure.


