Year of Introduction: 2017-18

Course Details

This is a non-credit course. Introduced to fulfil NAAC requirement. The course will be of 30 lectures of one-hour duration to be taught in one academic year. Any Student studying in First Year, Second Year and Third Year of any stream is eligible to undergo this Certificate Course. A Student is required to maintain 75 % of the Attendance, A teacher of any discipline may teach the course as Disaster Management (DM) is multi-disciplinary and draws its knowledge base from a range of disciplines. Lectures will be mostly organized on Sundays, Holidays and Vacations. Assessment of the Course will be conducted in the month of March/April, Minimura passing percentage is 40%.

Objectives of the Course

- To provide basic conceptual understanding of disasters and its relationships with development.
- 2. To gain understand approaches of Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) and the relationship between vulnerability, disasters, disaster prevention and risk reduction.
- 3. To enhance awareness of Disaster Risk Management institutional processes in India
- To build skills to respond to disasters
- Visit a disaster prone area to gaze the disaster

Learning Styles and Methods:

The Course will be taught using a combination of following learning styles and methods: Bloom's Taxonomy, Learn by Doing, Resource Based Learning, Observation-Based Learning, Cooperative Learning, Collaborative Learning, Inquiry Based & Computer Assisted Learning Methods.

Aims and objectives

The aims of first aid Preserve Life Not only the casualty's life, but your own as well. Far too often only one person's life is in danger when the emergency services are called, but by the time they arrive there are more. If you put your life in danger, you can end up fighting for your OWN life instead of the casualty's. Prevent the situation from Worsening The skilled first aider must take action to prevent the whole situation from becoming worse (e.g. removing dangers such as traffic or fumes), as well as acting to prevent the casualty's condition from deteriorating. Promote Recovery The actions of a first aider should, after preventing things from getting worse, help the casualty to recover from their illness or injury.

Eligiblity
