## Analysis Report

For the year 2021-2022 education was in online and offline mode, and the students satisfactory survey was taken on online mode out of 604 students 375 students have responded to the survey.

Majority of students have responded for the survey and most of them that is 70-95% of students have given positive marks to questions related to academics, assessment, soft skills, etc. Around 80-95% students are satisfied with the academic related questions like teacher preparedness, syllabus covered, teacher approaches, mentoring, etc and the students have responded in positive way to these questions. The rest of the students are not very strongly satisfied nor they are dissatisfied and that is the matter of concern to focus on and improve in the future.

Response to co-academic questions have got good response from the students to questions like encouragement by teacher, mentor follow up, multiple opportunities, field trip, etc that is 70-90% and the small percent of students response gave not a good response towards the survey and it will be focused to improve on it in future. For most of the questions students gave a good response that is more than 90%.

Students satisfactory survey was conducted online and students have responded well towards the survey. Majority of students are satisfied and only very little section of students are less satisfied about the same and it is the matter for us to focus and study the same.
