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Memorandum of Understanding

Between

**Dnyan Prabodhini Mandal's Shree Mallikarjun College
Delem-Canacona, Goa**

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into by the Goa Institute of Public Administration and Rural Development, Ela Farm, Old Goa, Tiswadi-Goa and Dnyan Prabodhini Mandal's Shree Mallikarjun College Delem-Canacona, Goa are hereinafter referred to jointly as the 'Parties'.

The parties having discussed the field of common interests for training, research and allied activities between the two institutions, have decided to enter into a collaboration.

Whereas, GIPARD, earlier known as Goa Institute of Rural Development & Administration (GIRDA), is established under notification No. 10/1/2014 PER (Part) in the Official Gazette, Series I No. 15 dated 10/07/2014 is the State of Goa's apex autonomous training institute, catering to training, capacity building, research and consultancy activities. The major target audience being elected representatives, officials, functionaries of government departments, Non Government Organisations, Self Help Groups, academicians and students,

Whereas, Dnyan Prabodhini Mandal's Shree Mallikarjun College is a premier Institution in the State of Goa that provides higher education and is actively involved in research, training and consultancy. It has been accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) with a cumulative grade point average of 2.81 out of 4.00.

Whereas, there is a need for both parties to work jointly in order to efficiently achieve their goals through mutual sharing and cooperation and collaborate for mutual benefit.

Now, therefore the parties agree to as follows:



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Article - I

- 1.1 The purpose of this MoU is to provide a framework of cooperation and facilitate collaboration between the parties to meet the broader goals of training and capacity building of government employees, elected representatives and civil society in the State. This collaboration would enable GIPARD to:
 - 1.2 a) to conduct a number of training programmes thereby trying to achieve the targets as mandated in the State Training Policy of Goa.
 - 1.3 b) to cater to the training programmes for the Elected Representatives at the block levels and district levels.

Article - II

2. The parties agree to cooperate in the following areas of activity:
 - a) to conduct training programmes allotted by GIPARD.
 - b) to provide faculty support in conducting the programmes at their premises.
 - c) to collaborate in research activities wherever the need arises.
 - d) to provide student support wherever needed for minor data collection.
 - e) to provide their infrastructure to conduct the training programmes, workshops, seminars, symposiums, etc.
 - f) to promote collaborative academic exchange through faculty, students, lectures and publications.

Article - III

Implementation of Memorandum of Understanding

- 3.1 All activities mentioned herein will be conducted as stipulated in the MoU.
- 3.2 a. GIPARD will prepare a training calendar every year and also allocate the number of training programmes which will be conducted off campus at different levels.

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- b. The institution will have to identify one faculty as the coordinator for conducting the programmes and research activities.
 - c. Budget for each programme will be prepared by GIPARD and allotted to the institute. 10% of the total programme cost towards institutional charges will be provided to the concerned institute, which will include payment of honorarium to Faculty/ Coordinator/Technical Assistant, etc., if any. Funds will be released on a quarterly basis to the institute.
 - d. The concerned institute will adhere to the necessary arrangements required for conducting the programme as per details mentioned in Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) enclosed with this MoU.
 - e. The institute will submit bills, vouchers and refund the unutilised funds to GIPARD, within 15 days after the programme is over.
 - f. The evaluation report and the report of the programme, group photo should be submitted along with the bills.
- 3.3 Neither party shall be agent, representative, or joint partner of the other party. Neither party shall enter into any contract or commitment on behalf of the other party.
 - 3.4 Neither party shall use the name, logo of the other party or any abbreviation thereof without the prior written approval of the other party.
 - 3.5 Nothing in this MoU grants either party the permission to create a hyperlink to the other's website, without the written authorization of the other party.

Article – IV

Term, Termination and Amendment

- 4.1 The proposed MoU is non-exclusive and shall be for two years from the date of commencing on 10th September 2019 and ending on 9th September 2021, unless terminated earlier.

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- 4.2 The MoU may be amended mutually by written agreement of the parties.
- 4.3 GIPARD will reserve the right for weekly monitoring of the programmes and related activities assigned to the party.

This MoU is being signed on this date the 10th of September 2019 and shall remain in force till 9th September 2021.

As part of the drive, an interactive session was held on the importance of Financial Literacy for the youths. The Guest Speaker was Mr. Praveer Kullu, a management professional (MBA). Mr Kullu completed his MBA from the prestigious Xavier Labour Relations Institute (XLRI) Jamshedpur. He also possesses a great deal of practical industrial experience and conducts training and coaching sessions.

Dr. Rupa Chari, Associate Professor, Department of Hindi welcomed the Guest speaker Mr. Praveer Kullu. Dr. Suchita Naik, Associate Professor in Commerce, introduced the speaker and highlighted on the topic.

Mr. Kullu discussed about the securities market, different shares, offer document, do's and don'ts in the security market, its myths and realities and selection of brokers. He also spoke about UTI, ULIP, SCORES. Further, he called upon the students to engage in research before venturing into investing the funds. He also stressed on the Indian Ideologies of looking at innovation from the ancient times till the present day. He introduced the participants to many exclusive examples and challenges in the world economy at



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large with reference to different societies and how youth can play an important role in development of economy with right investment done at right times. He shared his own experiences of how and why corporations can no longer just rely on the old formula that sustained innovation and growth for decades: a mix of top-down strategies, expensive R&D projects and rigid, highly structured innovation processes. According to him, it is the duties of youth to make people aware about investing money, where in there are large returns. Mr Kullu stressed in the urgent need for educating the Indians to take to investment.

Around 51 students attended the programme. The session was anchored by Mr. Keval Naik, Assistant Professor in Sociology and co-coordinator of GIPARD of Shree Mallikarjun College. The session concluded with the vote of thanks by Miss Nishigandha Naik Gaonkar Assistant Professor in Commerce.
