- 2) Library Seating Arrangement:45% present expressed it is Very Good,35%, followed by Excellent, 18% were of the opinion Good, 1% of the respondents expressed it is Fair, 1% expressed it is poor..
- 3) Arrangement of the Books on Shelves: 40% of the respondents said it is Very Good, 36% followed by Excellent, 21% followed by of them of the opinion it is Good, 3% said it is Fair.




