

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










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4. SANGAM 2024

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REPORT OF BAZAR DAY

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DEPARTMENT OF SCIENCE

As a part of Sangam 2024, on 30/01/2024 and 31/01/2024 the Department of Science organized Bazar Day in the Science building corridor. The main objective of the Bazar Day was to encourage students for entrepreneurship and business mindset through experiential learning. The second objective of Bazar Day was to motivate Students visiting college to pursue their higher studies in BSc Science. There were a total of 12 science Bazar stalls, of which 7 were dedicated to food stalls and 5 for game stalls. The total revenue generated was Rs. 15385 with a profit of Rs. 1715

For Bazhar Day day following food and other product stalls were placed:

a) Chem Chat:

Different types of Chats (Chana chat, Bhel chat, Puri chat, Spicy corn chat) were sold at this tall. This stall was established by TYBSc students Manjita Gaonkar, Sanjana Velip, Ankita Velip, Bofina Velip, Divya Gaonkar, Rutik Gaonkar and Jitendra Velip.

b) Bite station:

The food stall was put up by FYBSc students which offered an array of flavourful dishes, the food was enjoyed by many people who were coming for the SANGAM event. The bite station was beautifully decorated with attractive posters and music playing in the background where Customers could either grab a quick bite standing near the table or opt for takeaway to enjoy their meal on the go. The following menu was kept for the Still stall: fish cones (mackerel stuffing), Forminhas (veg), Corn chart, Custurd, and bread sandwiches.

c) Golgrab Shots:

It was a pani puri stall. The group members were Ankita, Deepiksha, Disha, Smesha. The puri has potato and chana stuffing along with a water mixture. Three type of water Mixtures tikha pani, meetha, khatta pani. One puri was of 10rs.



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d)Fructo- Citrusllas:

This stall sold different types of Fruit juices such as Watermelon Juice, Orange Juice, and Leman Juice. The stall was placed by Dhrithik Dhuri and Sahil Komarpant of TYBSc.

- e) Rasaynik Rangoli: The students of TYBSc Ekanti Metha and Leenashree Naik prepared and sold homemade organic rangoli at this stall. Different edible organic materials were used to prepare this rangoli in different colors (White, Pink, Green, Yellow, and Blue). This rangoli powder so edible and safe for children.
- f) **Citrus Juice:** This stall sold different juices and desserts such as lime soda and Casterd. It was placed by Pralhad Gaonkar, Pankaj Velip, and Anay Velip of SYBSc.
- g) **Heterogenous Fructo Fusion:** The students of SYBSc Vidhita Komarpant, Karina Phal Desai, and Janavi Gaonkar established this stall. They prepared different chats and Juices which were served at this stall.

a) Spot the Element:

- Donors were given refreshments on behalf of Sarthak foundation and JCI Margao.








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2. Eye Check-Up Camp
